PROJECT NARRATIVE

Please attach material, which responds to the follow five items in the order that they are presented.

1. In a brief paragraph, describe the project and its purpose, how and when it will be accomplished, and why it is important.

The purpose of the Lewiston Town Park at Pletcher Road Playground Construction project is to provide a new community playground that meets the needs of a growing section of the Town of Lewiston(The Town) and increasing the Town's ability to provide recreation opportunities in this public park in the Town of Lewiston. In its current condition, this park fails to serve the surrounding population or the Town of Lewiston at large with the quality recreational opportunities and amenities residents enjoy.

Lewiston Town Park at Pletcher Road (Pletcher Park) is located adjacent to the Niagara River, and is one of several Town-owned parks that the Town of Lewiston maintains. Pletcher Park will soon connect directly to the Niagara River through construction of the as-yet-to-be-named Lewiston Waterfront Park, and directly connects via bike path and trail to Kiwanis Park and Toohey Park in the Village of Lewiston. The new playground will replace the existing playground constructed in 1998, and increase the size of its structures and playable area.

This upgrade will enhance the attractiveness and functionality of the rest of this Park as a whole by providing more space that can be used for recreational activities. This project will also enhance the ability of this Park to serve the recreational needs of their respective community and the Town of Lewiston as a whole when integrated with our other Parks.

The Town of Lewiston declares that it is their opinion, shared by the Town of Lewiston Parks and Recreation Advisory Committee, that the completion of Lewiston Town Park at Pletcher Road Playground Project will have a positive effect on the use and usefulness of parks connected by the Niagara Greenway.

2. Referring to the Niagara River Greenway Plan, clearly document and describe how the proposed project will advance the Niagara River Greenway vision including the goals, principles, and criteria that define that vision. Niagara Greenway Vision Statement: The Niagara River Greenway is a world-class corridor of places, parks and landscapes that celebrates and interprets our unique natural, cultural, recreational, scenic, and heritage resources and provides access to and connections between these important resources while giving rise to economic opportunities for the region.

The Lewiston Town Park at Pletcher Road Playground Project will promote the vision of the Niagara River Greenway by supporting public parkland along the Niagara River to serve as a recreational gateway for visitors to the Greenway Corridor.

Pletcher Park is directly connected to pathways and trails that allow residents and visitors to drive, bike, hike, and/or jog to Lewiston's other parks as well as to the Niagara River, Devil's Hole State Park, and the NYS Reservoir Park. Pletcher Park is one of several Town-owned parks that the Town of Lewiston maintains. The Town's parks system is populated by Kiwanis Park, Lewiston Town Park, Sanborn Park, Colonial Village Park, Washuta Park, and the new Lewiston Waterfront Park (2021 construction). Pletcher Park also supports Lewiston's other parks by providing this proposed new Playground for visitors and the community's young residents. The Town maintains eleven baseball fields six of which are located at Pletcher Park. During the spring and summer months, the Town sponsors youth activities, Baseball and softball leagues and tournaments, instructional soccer, outdoor lacrosse, and supervised playground activities every weekday from the end of June to mid-August in its five parks. Fall baseball programs also begin at the end of August.

The Town's 2008 recreational survey and park inventory clearly indicated a critical need for parkland and open space. The limited municipal parks in Lewiston are currently overcrowded and force residents (mainly children) to be driven to other parks for recreation including educational recreation programs such as scouting, nature walks, orienteering, passive usage, etc.

This project incorporates all of the principles, goals and criteria set forth by the Niagara River Greenway, and the project will support an accessible, unified, environmentally friendly, and revitalized corridor that highlights the natural beauty, cultural diversity, and historic significance of the Niagara River.

PRINCIPALS

The implementation of the Lewiston Town Park at Pletcher Road Playground Project will meet the guiding principles of the Niagara Greenway Commission as follows:

Excellence The Town of Lewiston is committed to maintaining the excellence of all its recreational facilities. Pletcher Park is in close proximity to other Town and State parks, as well as bike trails. Pedestrians will capitalize on the Park's surrounding area's recreation amenities (playground equipment, recreation programs for youths, and Ball fields), pristine natural beauty, and scenic vistas, thus contributing to the Greenway Commission's first class standards.

Sustainability The Lewiston Town Park at Pletcher Road Playground Project will promote the *ecological, economic* and *physical* sustainability for long-term viability and effectiveness. The Town's Parks and Recreation Department will conscientiously maintain the project.

Accessibility Pletcher Park is located along the Niagara Corridor in the Town's of Lewiston and Niagara, thus facilitating improved public access to the Town's additional parks as well as the Niagara River Vistas. The proposed project is designed to provide and increase physical accessibility to its currently playground system.

Ecological Integrity The Lewiston Town Park at Pletcher Road Playground Project will support parkland that is used, and will improve the health, vitality, and integrity of the Park's natural resources. Adjacent wildlife habitats from the Niagara River, Stella Niagara Nature Preserve and Lewiston Plateau will continue to support the ecological significance in these areas and natural landscapes.

Public Well-Being Within the proposed project area of the Niagara River and Greenway Corridor, the Lewiston Town Park at Pletcher Road Playground Project will provide much-needed recreational opportunity to a wide range of users, including the community's youth and their parents who utilize the park for recreation, after-school programs, and community play. The Park's project will advance public well-being and promote physical and emotional wellness through the experience that it offers to the public by providing access to both active and passive recreational opportunities, and amenities for those with special needs. The project will provide improved access for various recreational activities and will support a relaxing atmosphere for all visitors.

Connectivity The Lewiston Town Park at Pletcher Road Playground Project will facilitate increased access to active recreation areas in Pletcher Park and will serve as a recreational destination for Town residents and the surrounding community. The Town maintains six of its community baseball fields within the Park for use by the community, and its spring, summer and fall baseball programs. This project will connect park users to additional equipment and recreational opportunities.

Restoration The location of the proposed playground creation will feature new equipment that will meet and exceed all regulations and standards. The project is designed to encourage the restoration of recreational resources and equipment, the safety of the surrounding landscape, as well as the protection of the environment.

Authenticity The Lewiston Town Park at Pletcher Road Playground Project will support the already established clear sense of "place" and identity that reflects the traditional spirit and heritage of the area.

Celebration This project will be designed to celebrate local history, diversity, cultural resources, and the natural and built environments, and will seek to share this diverse tradition with local residents and visitors to the region. Once this playground is complete it will only strengthen the sense of celebration during events and activities that help build social interaction and shared experiences throughout the Greenway corridor.

Partnerships The focus of the Lewiston Town Park at Pletcher Road Playground Project may not be a direct cooperation with neighboring municipalities but with many visitors to the park, as well as other local towns and villages this project will only

strengthen relationships with neighboring communities and may lend itself to future coordination and integration of efforts throughout the Greenway.

Community Based The Lewiston Town Park at Pletcher Road Playground Project has been in the planning stage for several months, with support provided by the Town's Director of Recreation (Mike Dashineau), Town Supervisor (Steve Broderick), and the Town of Lewiston's Town Board. The project reflects the preferences and plans of the local community, as reflected in the 2008 survey, while respecting other stated goals and the communal vision of the Niagara River Greenway. The project is vital in restoring the Park to meet the needs of the Town and the surrounding population and has the full support of the local community as expressed through the Town of Lewiston Parks and Recreation Advisory Committee.

GOALS: The implementation of the Lewiston Town Park at Pletcher Road Playground Project will meet the goals of the Niagara River Greenway as follows:

Improve Access Lewiston Town Park at Pletcher Road Playground Project will serve as a recreational destination for members and visitors of the community and will further support recreational activities and programs for the Town's youth. During both leisure Park enjoyment and organized Park activities, including youth baseball, softball and soccer games. Implementation of this project will significantly contribute to the improvement of the Town's park that has experienced a large increase of usage due to the increase in population within the Town and surrounding communities.

Make Connections

This project will facilitate increased access for Park users to new playgrounds and recreation areas in Pletcher Park and will serve as a recreational destination for Town residents and the surrounding community. The Town maintains six of its community baseball fields within the Park for use by the community and its spring, summer and fall baseball programs, as well as a skate park, shelters, a golf green, horseshoe pits, and concessions for similar programs. This project will connect park users to additional equipment and recreational opportunities.

Protect and Restore Environmental Systems This project will ensure that Pletcher Park remains as an open viable parkland space, as well as preserve the surrounding environment from commercial and residential development. The project contributes to the environmental well-being of the region.

Spark Revitalization and Renewal The Lewiston Town Park at Pletcher Road Playground Project addresses the heart of the Greenway's goal for revitalization and renewal of green spaces and public recreational opportunities. Pletcher Park serves as a recreational destination for visitors and much of the community's youths through its spring, summer and fall baseball programs, skate park and soccer instruction. The

replacement of current playground and antiquated equipment will offer a more user-friendly and safe environment for all that use these areas.

Promote Long Term Sustainability As the Town of Lewiston currently owns the property, the Town will continue to ensure that Pletcher Park playground and recreational structures are maintained and updated to remain an attractive destination along the Niagara River Greenway, Revitalization of the Park will be conscientiously maintained well into the future through its recreational events and programs, the connection between Pletcher Park and Lewiston's other Town parks will contribute to the vitality of the area as it continues to serve as an attractive and essential gateway and stopover along the Niagara River Greenway and trail systems. The Town is committed to the yearly funding and manpower that are necessary to keep the Park and its amenities in top condition.

Extend the Legacy of Fredrick Law Olmstead Currently the Town of Lewiston has limited public recreational property available for the enjoyment of residents and visitors. Due to the recent increase in population and the projected continuance of that trend, The Lewiston Town Park at Pletcher Road Playground Project will provide local residents and visitors to the area with improved access to the Park's playground equipment and continued access to baseball diamonds, other park amenities. The new equipment will facilitate safer conditions for its users, and will make equipment available for each of the Park's target segments so users of all ages can make use of the equipment and recreational areas.

Celebrate History and Heritage The creation of a new playground will meet the specialized needs of all that use this area. This project will draw people from the Town, as well as visitors to the area, thus providing additional recreational amenities to serve the steadily increasing population. Throughout its history, the Town of Lewiston has been a close-knit community within itself, as well as, with surrounding municipalities. All five of Lewiston's parks support its heritage and pride of its park system, which includes Kiwanis Park.

CRITERIA Through the Lewiston Town Park at Pletcher Road Playground Project, the Town of Lewiston meets criteria of the Niagara River Greenway Plan:

Consistency with Niagara River Greenway Principles The Lewiston Town Park at Pletcher Road Playground Project makes a significant contribution towards all the principles set forth by the Niagara River Greenway. This project encourages the vision for the Greenway to be explicitly considered for project development, at the basic vision, to see the space around and near the Niagara River become developed and to attract residents and visitors to utilize this space while experiencing the natural resource provided by the Niagara River.

Priority Status The Lewiston Town Park at Pletcher Road Playground Project has been in the planning phase for several months to restore and enhance several recreation

opportunities for users of all ages, including the community's abundant, increasing youth population, Pletcher Park supports the pride of Lewiston's parks system and will enhance the overall attractiveness and usability of the parks for the community

Focus Area The implementation of the proposed project will visually improve the aesthetics and functionality of the Pletcher Park property and, as it is within close driving proximity, other Town and State parks and attractions along the Niagara Corridor. The improvements to the Park will have a local and regional impact at the heart of the Greenway.

Environmental Soundness The conceptual plan has addressed the need to provide proper maintenance of landscaping and plant life, as well as return any disturbed ground to its original condition. The new play area will include increased drainage for rain water to access designed runoff areas.

Implementable A contractor will perform all work associated with this project. The cost was figured out by gathering cost estimates from contractors (please see enclosed quote and budget). Once approved, this project will be put out to bid for equipment prices and installation.

Economic Viability and Local Sponsor All maintenance and upkeep of the Park will be provided through a line item in the Town of Lewiston Parks and Recreation Department Budget. The Town of Lewiston will continue to provide stewardship for this project, and provide the necessary money, equipment, and manpower to further this project along from the design phase to its completion and beyond.

Availability of Local Sponsor or Partner The Town of Lewiston is committed to developing and maintaining this park as part of its yearly budget and thus will assume the long-term responsibility for continued operation and maintenance. The Town will ensure that the playground will not fall into disrepair and will continue to champion the project after it is completion.

Ability to Match or Leverage Funds

The Town Lewiston will not be providing any matching funds for this project.

Clear Benefits The Lewiston Town Park at Pletcher Road Playground Project will serve as a passive recreation destination, linking surrounding communities for recreational activities, programs, and sporting events, will improve the quality of life in our growing community, and enhance tourism and the visitor experience for those visiting the Greenway.

As described previously the Town of Lewiston does not currently have the ability to match or leverage funds, so without funding from Greenway this project is not possible. The Town of Lewiston will continue to provide stewardship for this project once its complete, and provide the necessary money, equipment, and manpower to protect this project beyond completion.

This project, which has been in the planning phase for several months, has received strong community support from residents, organizations, and local representatives and is fully supported by the local governing body for the Town of Lewiston (see attached resolution).

This project will provide excellent opportunities for environmental and geological education, outreach, and community involvement. Once completed, this project will:

- Restore and protect ecologically and geologically significant landscapes;

- Create/enhance public access to a natural resource;
- Result in the restoration of an area, which has been long neglected and underutilized, and no longer meets the needs of the surrounding community; Protect and enhance those scenic, historic and cultural resources, which are readily identifiable as valued parts of the common heritage of New York's citizens by facilitating convenient access to the Niagara River and Erie Canal and,
- Maintain the critical natural-resource-based industries, recreation, and tourism.

The Lewiston Town Park at Pletcher Road Playground Project will provide improved access recreational opportunities for *all* Park community users (youths, adults and seniors). This project entails the creation of a new playground and play area at Pletcher Road Park, 487 Pletcher Road, Lewiston, NY by adding a playground system that is commensurate wit the growing population of the surrounding area as well as the ability of the Park to serve as an active recreation destination for Town residents and visitors. As Pletcher Park is a vital part of the Town's recreational parks system, it is a destination stop along the Niagara River Corridor and is within close proximity to additional Town and State parks to encourage more participation in recreation and provide a stop for trail users along the way.

The proposed project's improvements will allow the Town to continue its tradition of providing its residents and the surrounding community with open space for recreation and environmental conservation. There were no relevant studies necessary for this project, and all SEQR documentation will be obtained once before the project commences.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Town Board authorizes the Supervisor to sign all documents and agreements related to the Niagara River Greenway Program application

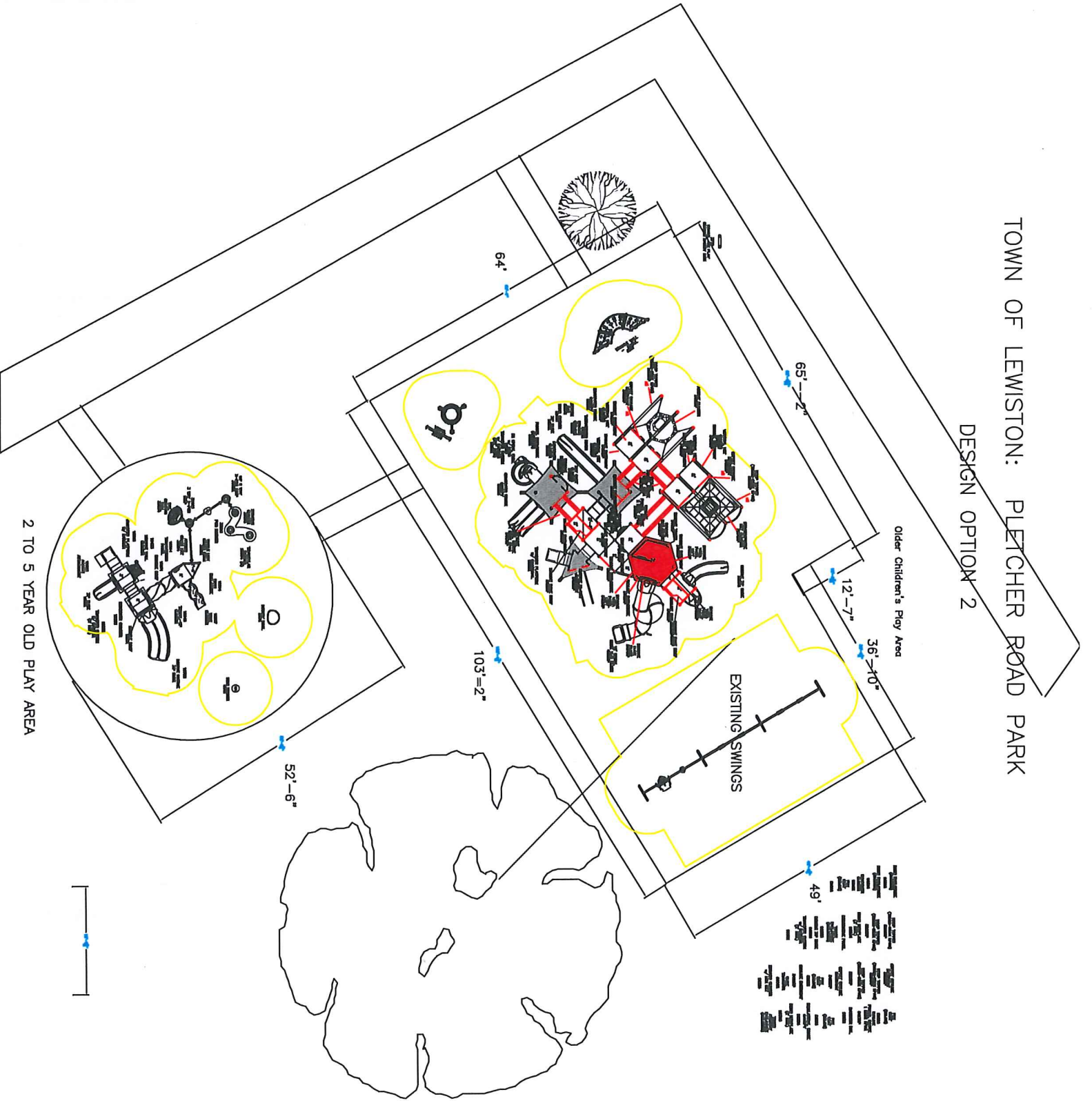

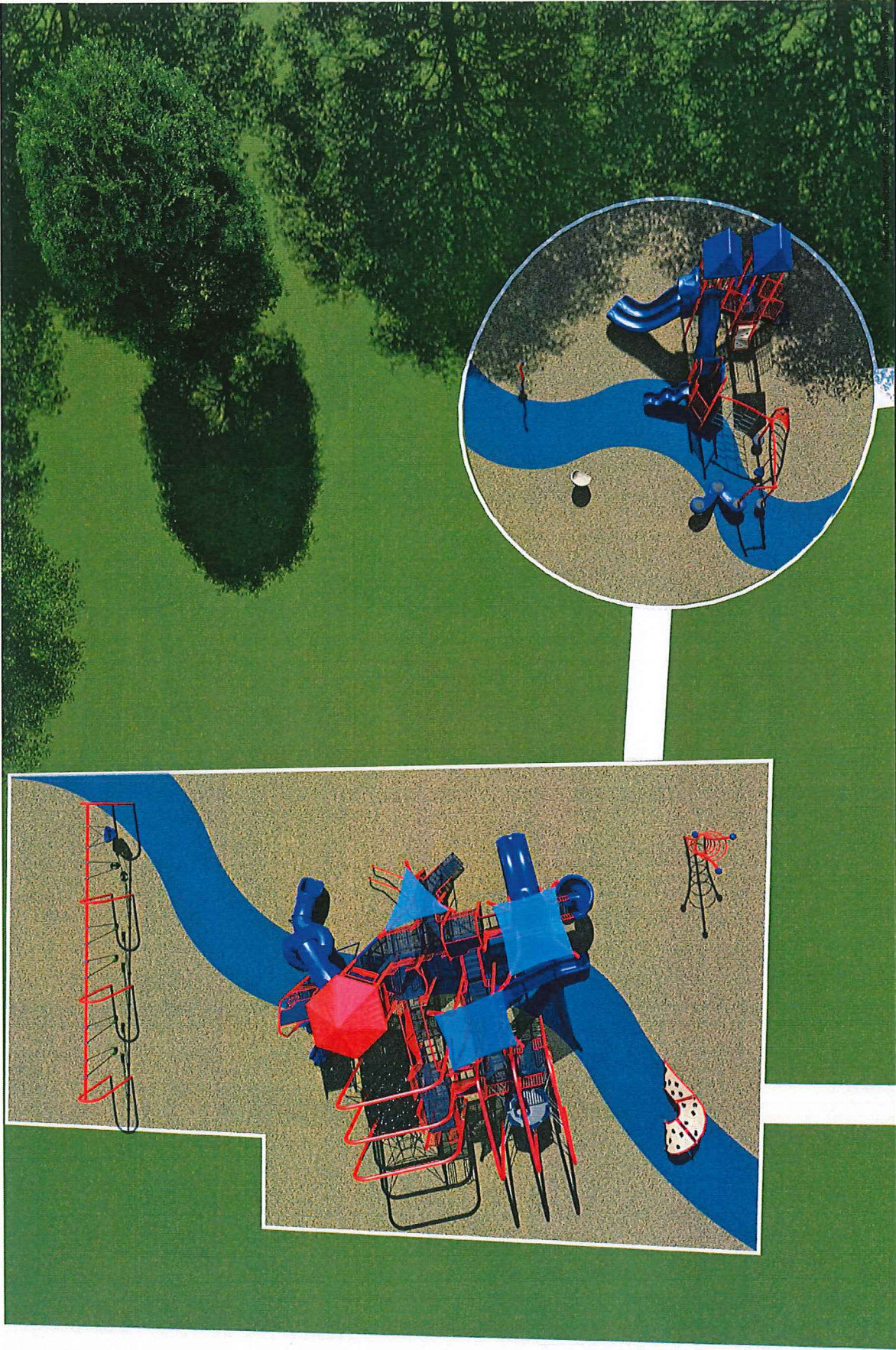
